1<sup>st</sup> line – title of article (all capital letters, bold).

2<sup>nd</sup> line – full name of author / coauthors (italic).

3<sup>rd</sup> line – workplace, the city (italic).

4<sup>th</sup> line – e-mail of author / coauthors (italic).

5<sup>th</sup> line – blank line.

Alignment – on the center.

6<sup>th</sup> line – text of article (with indent 1,25 cm).

At the end of the article – a list of references.

After the article – title of the article, authors' information, an annotation (7-12 lines) in English.

**Size:** up to 12 pages.

Language: English, Polish, and Ukrainian.

**Number of co-authors:** up to 3.

The registration fee for participation in the conference is 150 PLN (890 UAH / 50 C / 50 USD). The registration fee is used to partially cover the costs of preparation and holding of the conference, the publication of a collective monograph and distribution of mandatory copies.
