* Conditions for Ukrainian applicants for a study tour to Japan:

1. Logistics, visa

- (1) Participating in the study tour is a subject of participants' will.
- (2) Participants will be taking the flight to Japan from Warsaw.
- (3) Under the present Martial Law, <u>participants are expected to ensure their eligibility to cross</u>
 <u>the border and stay abroad for the period of the training course by themselves.</u>
- (4) Participants will apply for their visa at the Japanese Embassy in Kyiv (The visa process takes 5 working days).

2. Travel to Poland

- (1) JICA will reimburse the travel expenses to/from Poland and accommodation in Warsaw (if needed) upon arrival in Japan.
- (2) Participants are requested to arrange transportation, hotel, etc. by themselves.

3. Quarantine:

(1) Participants might have to follow the quarantine rules of the Japanese Government at the time of the trip (subject to pandemic situation)
